Policy on Photography

Upon having a child accepted for the school, the parent with whom the school contracts is asked to agree to the child being photographed on occasion by a teacher or individual validated by the school. This permission is signed for on the terms and conditions of which they keep a copy for themselves and return a copy to us at The Meadows. This enables the school to proceed with the taking of photographs for publicity shots, and at special occasions such as Christmas.

Every parent has the right to refuse this request, in which case the child must not be photographed by any member of staff, by a parent, or by an outsider without the express permission for that occasion of the parent with whom the nursery has a contract.

While pictures of children may be used as part of the publicity of the school, we would always seek permission if they were going to be used off the premises, no pictures of children will be displayed on the school website, nor will they be made available to anyone in a digital form.

Where pictures are made available to the press or television, they will not be released with the names of the child unless the contracting parent gives express permission for this to be done.
