# Our Montessori Classroom Environment

Our classrooms are very special places. Designed to be simple, beautiful spaces, they create an environment that enhances the ability to learn. From the simple wooden shelves to the displays on the wall – everything is clean, tidy, ordered, and ready for your child to enter into and start to work.

Everything in the room has a place and an order. Materials are chosen according to individual children’s needs and the ‘theme’ of the half term. They are then placed on the shelves for the children to use. There are also core materials that are in place to support the main areas of learning for each child.

In our classrooms you will find children working in small groups at tables or on the floor. They may be working independently or 1-1 with a teacher. They will be chatting to each other or maybe sitting quietly by themselves.

In one session many subjects may be taking place. Maths, Literacy, Geography, History, Science, role play, writing, drawing, painting, reading. The room will be full of these subjects, maybe with a teacher directing a small group on a particular activity.

The class teachers are not dominant adults in a room of children. You may even have to hunt for the teacher when you enter the room. We direct, observe, discuss, and reflect with the children – at their level, where they are, even if that is laying on the floor!
