

TEACHER OF BTEC SPORT LEVEL 2

JOB DESCRIPTION

Qualification lessons at The Meadows Montessori High School are one hour long and occur once a week. They are taught in small groups of up to four.

Your main responsibilities as a BTEC Sport teacher at our school are:

- to plan interesting schemes of work that prepare students for completing their qualification to the best of their ability;
- to deliver interesting and engaging BTEC Sport lessons that suit the needs of your learners;
- to set appropriate follow up work that consolidates and extends the learning in the lessons;
- to assess learner progress regularly, keep records of these assessments and report to parents on student progress formally twice a year;
- to check students meet follow up work deadlines and keep the senior leaders informed if not;
- to communicate with senior leaders on the progress of your students generally;
- to source and provide mock examinations for your students when requested;
- to communicate with your learners during the week if they contact you through the school systems for support, within reason;
- to be prepared to deliver your subject in a way that is in keeping with our school's ethos;
- to promote the safeguarding of all pupils in the school and work in line with statutory safeguarding guidance (e.g. Keeping Children Safe in Education, Prevent) and our safeguarding and child protection policies;
- to work with the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) to promote the best interests of pupils, including sharing concerns where necessary.

We will undertake all the required pre-employment checks including an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check and a children's barred list check for all positions.
